For the first edition of its workshop, the CiThe network is organising four days to study the subject of the character, a topic that allows for the broadly supported and multidisciplinary approach proposed by WORK IN PROCESS *#1-Is the character still necessary?* We will examine the character through the prisms of different disciplines. From the time when the character emerged in theatre as the first 'actant' of the narrative and subsequently embodied a psychological development, which took a collective form in the tragic chorus and an individual form in the heroic epic, opera and then film embraced those functions of the character as bearer of action and psychology.

However, the notion of the character is also present in non-fictional media such as documentary film, in which the character is often underestimated, even though every aspect of the creative process (from framing to editing) is designed to ensure that the character emerges from reality. And when stage representation dispenses with discourse, the character takes shape through the body, as in dance, performance and circus, especially since the post-dramatic turn. But the character can also be formed through sound, far beyond what is commonly accepted in music or opera. Moreover, technical developments in both film and theatre have propelled the concept of character in different directions, taking it as far as set design and scenography.

Considering the multiplicity of these possibilities and these different media and their mutations, is the character still necessary? What about identification? What is the status of the character in the current confusion between the "person" and the "image", and what new representations might be possible? And above all, is it possible to enrich the practices of all art disciplines that will be explored during these four days by comparing different methods of constructing the character? We will try to seek answers to these questions through discussions and presentations during WORK IN PROCESS *#1-Is the character still necessary*?
